

SELECTION CRITERIA AND ELIGIBILITY

ELIGIBILITY FOR EACH CATEGORY

Horses

1. Any horse that has won the Garryowen Equestrienne Turnout.
2. Horses still competing are eligible.

Riders

1. Any rider who has won the Garryowen Equestrienne Turnout.
2. Riders still competing are eligible.

Exceptional Service

Any person outside those set aside for riders who have made an outstanding contribution to the Garryowen. This category includes owners, trainers, stewards, judges, officials, media, administrators and anyone else who has made an outstanding contribution to the Garryowen Event.

Restrictions

One inductee maximum, per person, per category, will be inducted into the hall of fame. It is not necessary to accept an inductee per category each year.

GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION

Horses

1. Consideration will be given to the number of times a horse has won the Garryowen.
2. Consideration will be given to the consistency of results achieved in all aspects of the horse's competition career.

Riders

1. Consideration will be given to the number of times a rider has won the Garryowen.
2. Consideration will be given to the number of times the rider has entered the Garryowen.
3. Riders that have made an outstanding contribution to enhancing the reputation of the Garryowen will be highly regarded.
4. Consideration will be given to the consistency of results achieved in all aspects of the rider's competition career.

Exceptional Service

1. Consideration will be given to the level of support provided by the nominee.
2. Consideration will be given to the impact the nominee's support has had on the Garryowen.
3. Consideration will be given to the number of years the nominee has supported the Garryowen.

Please ensure you address the selection criteria and nominees are eligible when completing your nomination.
